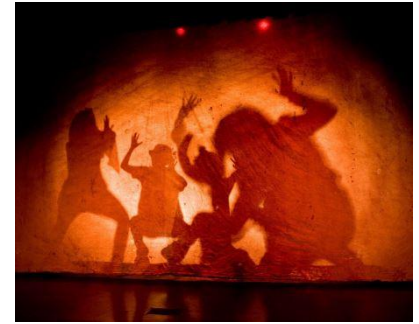

ArtMix's Urban Artisans program supports young adults, ages 16-22 in the transition from school to the workplace. Students with and without disabilities learn transferable, pre-vocational skills through making, marketing, and selling artwork in a professional art studio.

Artwork is created to fulfill commissions and to sell in galleries and retail shops. Urban Artisans was a 2015 winner of the prestigious National Arts and Humanities Youth Program Award.

The 8 week summer session starts June 3 and ends July 24, 2019. Available work hours are:

Interns are paid an hourly wage of \$7.25/hour and can work up to 9 hours per week. Studios are located in the Harrison Center for the Arts at 1505 N. Delaware Street, Indianapolis, IN 46202

## 2019 Indiana 4-H Entrepreneurship Academy

Applications are now being accepted for the 2019 Indiana 4-H Entrepreneurship Academy. On June 12-14th youth from across Indiana will develop a better understanding of entrepreneurship to begin making an impact in their local communities. Entrepreneurship Academy is sponsored by Indiana 4-H Youth Development as a 3-day event for high school Indiana students.

Throughout the Academy, participants will attend in-depth workshops to help youth further develop their business idea. The event culminates in final pitch presentation the morning of June 14th. Since 2007, the academy has hosted 446 Indiana youth from a variety of Indiana communities. Over 80% of Academy alumni attend an Indiana college or university, and of these youth, half of them attend Purdue University.

Youth who participate in Entrepreneurship Academy:

- Increase their understanding of what it takes to start a business and gain skills to do so.
- Understand the barriers and risks involved in building a successful business.
- Interact with real-world entrepreneurs with ties to Purdue University.
- Deliver their business pitch to seasoned entrepreneurs and business owners, and receive valuable feedback.

## **2019 SUMMER CAMP SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE**

A thousand full scholarships for low-income, gifted students between the ages of 10 and 17 to attend weeklong summer camps at several prestigious universities in North America are being offered thanks to a generous grant of \$1.2 million from the Nudelman Family Trust.

Students will be able to attend summer programs at 16 locations across the US and Canada, including Stanford, Harvard, New York University, UCLA, USCD, UC Irvine, the University of Washington, University of Chicago, UT Austin, University of Houston, University of Pennsylvania, Duke, George Washington University, the University of British Columbia, University of Toronto, and McGill.

The scholarships will be awarded based on both merit and need, and will cover the cost of tuition, meals, and facility fees. The grant does not cover overnight stay at the universities. An equal number of scholarships will be awarded to girls and boys. The summer camp opportunities are being offered through Digital Media Academy.
